## AUDITOR WARRANT, LANDFILL BOND DECLARATION, ELECTRONIC RECORDS AND RETENTION

Administrator Hanson presented for approval a Termination of Declaration which states that Pipestone County previously filed a "state of Minnesota, General Obligation Bond Financed Property Declaration" in the Office of the Pipestone County Recorder, recorded on August 12, 2011. The originals of permanent records must be maintained unless the Minnesota Historical Society gives permission to allow the County to maintain the record as a scanned file and destroy the originals.
