Pipestone County Truth in Taxation Public Hearing

The Pipestone County Commissioners met with Chairman Les Nath and Commissioners Chris Hollingsworth, Luke Johnson, Bruce Kooiman, Dan Wildermuth and County Auditor Tyler Reisch present for the Truth in Taxation Public Meeting. Other Department Heads in attendance: County Assessor Joyce Schmidt, County Engineer David Halbersma, Emergency Services/Management Director Steve Ewing, Human Resources Coordinator/Interim Administrator Cathy Feste, and Information Technology Director Bill Folger. Chairman Nath called the public meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Chairman Nath welcomed those in attendance and explained the purpose of the Hearing. Auditor Tyler Reisch presented information on the proposed Levy Taxes Payable 2018 and the proposed 2018 Budget.
