Pipestone County Commissioner Meeting January 14, 2020

The Pipestone County Commissioners met with Chairman Bruce Kooiman,

Administrator Steve Ewing was also present. Chairman Kooiman called the meeting to order at

9:00 AM with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Motion by Wildermuth, seconded by Hollingsworth to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

PROJECT UPDATES, PROJECTS UNDER CONTRACT, PROJECTS IN THE PLANNING STAGE

County Engineer Nick Bergman provided information on project updates, projects under contract and projects in the planning stage.

Motion by Nath, seconded by Johnson to approve final payment for 2019 overlays (CP 2016-067, SAP 059-602-028, and SAP 059-608-026) to Central Specialties Inc, Alexandria, MN in the amount \$45,745.51. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Wildermuth, seconded by Hollingsworth to set a letting date of February 11, 2020 at 10:30a.m. for project SAP 059-61-015 widening/paving project on CSAH 13 between CSAH 2 and Highway 30. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Johnson, seconded by Nath to set the Annual Road and Bridge Hearing on Tuesday, March 3, 2020 at the Highway Department Conference Room. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Wildermuth, seconded by Hollingsworth to approve the purchase of a truck lift adapter at a cost of \$4,149.67. Motion carried unanimously.

Engineer Bergman reported that the 1998 Chevy 1500 Pickup has been posted for sale on dreamdirt.com by Livermont Auction.

Engineer Bergman gave an update on Maintenance activities including snow and ice removal, dirt work at the gravel bit before freezing, installation of snow fence, cold mix patching, and tree work.

County Administrator Steve Ewing presented a draft Resolution for consideration to send to MNDOT requesting concrete surfacing from Pipestone to Russell. The final draft of the Resolution will be presented at a later date.

ARCASEARCH DIGITAL RECORDS

County Administrator Steve Ewing requested approval of a proposal from Arcasearch in which they would scan Commissioners Minutes from 1879 through 2019, Courthouse Building Plans, Railroad Maps, Ditch Records, and City Plat Maps at an estimated cost of \$17,419.00. This price would also include the first year of the Compass Eclipse Research System Annual Fee. The Compass Eclipse Research System makes the search and retrieval of Commissioners Minutes accessible to the public through the Pipestone County website and cost of the system from year two forward is \$1,495.00 annually. Recorder DeGroot has approved the expenditure from the Recorders Compliance Fund. Motion by Hollingsworth, seconded by Wildermuth to approve the proposal from Arcasearch to scan County Records at a cost of \$17,419.00 to be paid out of the Recorders Compliance Fund. Motion carried unanimously.
