The gravel pit was previously owned by Pipestone County and sold to the Sportsman's Club in 2022. Environmental Administrator Kyle Krier stated that Aggregate tax funds can be used for this purpose. There is approximately \$28,177.85 currently in that account. Sommers reported that they received a quote from Double D Gravel for the first phase of the restoration project, totaling \$19,500.00.
